Dear EPIC Families,

It is my pleasure to make the announcement that we have all been waiting for! EPIC will re-open for five day a week in-person instruction on Monday, April 12! Details about our re-opening have been sent via Parent Square. While we will continue to support our students who elect to remain in distance learning for the remainder of the 2020-2021 school year, we encourage all families to take advantage of the opportunity to return to in-person learning.

When we return in person, EPIC will look and feel a little different due to state-required mandatory COVID 19 safety protocols. However, our goal at EPIC is to return to "normal" as much as we can while following safety protocols. Unfortunately, we are still unable to hold after school program, sports, and most extra-curricular activities until we receive approval from the health department.

I would like to thank all of our staff, students and families for their adherence to our COVID-19 safety protocols, especially the proper use of face coverings. The use of face coverings in California is an important component to us being able to re-open EPIC. Based on Governor Newsom's latest announcement, it is apparent that the use of face coverings is here to stay for the foreseeable future and we appreciate your support in wearing them while on the EPIC property as well as encouraging your students to wear them properly.
